Idyllwild grinding facility to operate three days per week

Facility will be open and operational Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays effective May 1

As winter weather gives way to warmer temperatures, the summer schedule will soon be in effect for the Idyllwild grinding facility. Effective May 1, 2021 the facility will resume Monday operations. The additional day of operations mean the facility will be open Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. (closed noon to 1 p.m. for lunch) from May 1 through November 30, 2021.

The facility is located at the 5,000-foot marker, one mile south of the Idyllwild transfer station on Highway 243. The grinding facility accepts wood waste affected by the bark beetle. Prohibited waste includes household waste, appliances, e-waste, metals, tires and other hazardous, explosive and medical wastes. Customers who use the facility pay a per-ton rate on pre-paid accounts.
