



What is the Construction and Demolition Waste Diversion Program?

The Construction and Demolition (C&D) Waste Diversion Program is designed to assist applicants in diverting C&D waste from landfills as required by the CalGreen Building Code (CCR, Title 24, Part 11 - CALGreen).

During the building permit entitlement process, applicants must satisfy the requirements of the C&D Waste Diversion Program in order to obtain a building permit and final inspection for the project.

C&D Waste Diversion Program

The C&D Waste Diversion Program consists of two parts:

Part 1: Form B – Waste Recycling Plan

Part 2: Form C – Waste Reporting Form



Part 1 – Waste Recycling Plan

The Waste Recycling Plan (Form B) serves as the “plan” on how the applicant will recycle C&D waste to meet the 65% diversion requirement.

Form B:

- Identify project materials
- Identify a method of diversion
- Identify recycling and/or disposal sites

Remember

Keep all receipts
to submit with
Form C

Part 2 – The Waste Reporting Form

The Waste Reporting Form (Form C) documents the actual recycling and disposal that took place during the project. Receipts verifying recycling and disposal tonnages, along with any photo documentation/verification, are needed to demonstrate compliance with the 65% diversion requirement.

Form C:

- Report project materials
- Report diversion method
- Report recycling/disposal facility names
- Calculate landfilled material
- Calculate recycled material
- Calculate Diversion Rate

PROCESSING TIME & FEES?

Processing Time

Processing time may take up to 3 business days for clearance once an application is deemed complete. Call (951) 486-3200 to get an update on the clearance.

Fees

The RCDWR does not charge a fee for processing Form B – Waste Recycling Plan or Form C – Waste Reporting Form.
